Operating Capacities

- The Rosa Power Plant in UP generated 8.15 billion units. The plant's availability increased to 95% in the current year compared to 92% in the previous year.
- The 40 MW Dhursar Solar PV plant in Rajasthan operated at a PLF 20.6% generating 72 million units.
- The 45 MW Wind capacity in Vashpet, Maharashtra operated at 19% PLF generating 56 million units in its first year of operations.
- 1,980 MW (3 x 660 MW) of power capacity has been commissioned at the Sasan Ultra Mega Power Plant located in Madhya Pradesh. The 20 MTPA Sasan Coal mines – the largest coal mine in India – is already operational.
- Entire 600 MW of Butibori power plant is now fully operational and supply has commenced to R-Infra Mumbai distribution licensee under 25 years long term PPA approved by MERC.

Capacities under Construction

- Construction work is in full swing for the remaining three units of the Sasan UMPP and each unit is on track to be commissioned in the current year.
- The 100 MW Concentrated Solar Power (CSP) project in Dhursar, Rajasthan is in advanced stage of commissioning. This will be the largest CSP plant to be commissioned under the government's National Solar Mission.
